Amendment to the 2016-2017 Evaluation Workplan

Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The UNECE Biennial Evaluation Workplan 2016-2017 (see ANNEX) includes the following 4 evaluations (one at the programme-level and three at the sub-programme level):
 - 1. Review of UNECE efforts to promote cross-sectoral collaboration and an integrated approach to sustainable development work (programme-level);
 - 2. Assessment of the relevance of the 2014-2017 UNECE/FAO Integrated Programme of Work to the needs of member States and the challenges in the forest sector;
 - 3. Review of the case studies of the application of best practice guidance for coal mine methane management;
 - 4. Review of UNECE work on measuring sustainable development and related areas.
- 2. The plan was approved prior to a decision of the UN Office for Internal Oversight Services (OIOS) to undertake a thematic evaluation of Regional Commissions in 2016. It was decided by OIOS that the focus of the 2016 OIOS thematic evaluation of Regional Commissions is statistical work. In particular, the objective of the evaluation is "to determine, as systematically and objectively as possible, the relevance and effectiveness of regional commissions' statistical work in support of measuring the achievements and the implementation of internationally agreed development goals."
- 3. The inception report of the OIOS evaluation notes that "the evaluation will identify the lessons learned and good practices that could be applied in supporting member States with implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the 2030 development agenda." Therefore, information on how UNECE statistical work is contributing to the measurement of sustainable development will be contained in the OIOS evaluation.
- 4. In light of the above, it is proposed to cancel evaluation n.4 from the 2016-2017 Evaluation Work Programme, as overtaken by the OIOS evaluation. It is also suggested that inter-divisional aspects of the statistical work promoting cross-sectoral collaboration and an integrated approach to sustainable development work be addressed and highlighted in the context of Evaluation n.1 of the UNECE Evaluation Work Plan.
- 5. Resources freed by cancelling Evaluation n.4 will be used to support other internal evaluations of UNECE.

For Decision:

EXCOM approval is sought to delete from the 2016-2017 Evaluation Workplan, the evaluation entitled "Review of UNECE work on measuring sustainable development and related areas". Further, EXCOM may wish to request that inter-divisional aspects of the statistical work promoting cross-sectoral collaboration and an integrated approach to sustainable development work be addressed in the "Review of UNECE efforts to promote cross-sectoral collaboration and an integrated approach to sustainable development work (programme-level)".
