- 34,000 authorized transporters in 62 countries conducted 858,100 TIR transports;
- annually, 89 per cent of global production of new cars, trucks and buses and 53 per cent of new motorcycles comply with United Nations facilitation tool Regulations or United Nations Global Technical Regulations.
- 150 to 200 million consignment notes are issued annually in Europe alone for international trips through the Convention for the International Carriage of Goods by Road (CMR); this number increases to approximately 1 billion if national freight transport is included. Perishable Foodstuffs
- over 450 million vehicles in Europe, Central Asia, North Africa and the Middle East use Green Cards, 129 countries have issued millions of International Driving Permits.
- The total length of the E waterway network has been increased by 6 per CH cent and is now 29,238 km, while the share of E waterways that comply Convention on with the AGN standards increased from 79 to 83 per cent.




