Further to the Commission's query regarding windfarms and EIA, please find attached 2 PDF documents which contain the following details:

1. Decided Wind Farm / Wind Turbine Cases with an EIS from 1999 to present
2. Decided Wind Farm / Wind Turbine Cases without an EIS from 1999 to present

An Bord Pleanála has advised that ' Decided Wind Farm / Wind Turbine Cases without an EIS' generally fall into three categories; 1) Permission denied 2)an application considered an exempted development / under the threshold 3)applications that were on hand prior to the amendment of the EIA Directive to include developments of this nature.
