6.1 Actions to be implemented during 2012 (60 min)

Action	Background
The DCG will discuss and agree on actions for the implementation of the MoU during 2012: 1. Establish sustainably functioning support structures: (a) In order to advance towards meeting the aim and objectives of the MoU, there is need for the DCG to: • Establish support structures in response to the: - mandate stemming from the MoU i.e. coordinate actions for the implementation of the MoU hence function as a de facto joint commission responsible for coordination and provision of advice to the Parties for the management of the Drin Basin; - additional current or future functions i.e. (i) steering committee of the two Projects financed by ENVSEC and SEPA; (ii) if accepted by donors, assist in the coordination of transboundary projects; (iii) be the governing body of the planned GEF funded project (if approved); • Sustain its functioning in 2012 in accordance to the MoU (until financing from GEF or other sources for the implementation of the MoU becomes available – see also point c below).	- Concept Note - ToR of the three working groups
(b) The establishment of Expert Working Groups has already been decided by the DCG with the aim to support the implementation of the MoU by (i) supporting the work of the DCG and strengthen its capacity to coordinate activities and; (ii) contributing to the deepening of cooperation among national institutions that will participate in the working groups: - Water Framework Directive implementation EWG - Monitoring and Information exchange EWG - Biodiversity and Ecosystem EWG.
