THE ABOVE-MENTIONED CONVENTION

I have the honour, upon instructions from the Secretary-General, to refer to letter C.N.306.1978.TREATIES-8 of 22 December 1978 transmitting a copy of the text in English and French of certain amendments proposed by the Government of Sweden to annexes 2 and 6 to the Customs Convention on the International Transport of Goods under Cover of TIR Carnets (TIR Convention), done at Geneva on 14 November 1975.

I wish to inform you that no objection having been notified to the Secretary-General by 1 May 1979, the amendments in question, in accordance with the decision of the Administrative Committee of 20 October 1978, will enter into force on 1 August 1979.
