

NATIONAL CONTROL MEASURES

New order No. 828 of 01.08.2003 by the State Customs Committee of the Russian Federation

Note by the TIR secretariat

- 1. The State Customs Committee of the Russian Federation has adopted Order No. 828 which came into force on 1 September 2003 and which will be effective until 1 January 2004 when the newly adopted Customs Code of the Russian Federation is scheduled to enter into force.
- 2. According to SCC, the main objective of Order No. 828 is to facilitate Customs procedures at road border crossings with a view to reducing unnecessary delays and queues. The Order has introduced deadlines for Customs officials when conducting Customs procedures at border crossings. In particular, a Customs transit operation has to be started within 15 min from the moment the transport operator has submitted the necessary documents, unless a decision regarding physical inspection has been taken (see para. 3 below).
- 3. Physical inspection may only be performed in the following cases:
- Customs seals are missing, broken or different from those indicated in accompanying documents;
- the load compartment is found to have major defects;
- the TIR Carnet (ATA Carnet) bears no Customs stamps of the country(ies) of departure and country(ies) of transit;
- the consignment note has not been signed or stamped by the consignor and the transport operator;

- there are uncertified erasures and over-writings in transport and commercial documents;
- there are evidences of a Customs infringement or there is relevant intelligence in writing;
- at the written request of the transport operator or his representative;
- physical examination is obligatory according to specific SCC orders related to high-sensitive goods.
- 4. The above list is exhaustive. Physical inspections have to be carried out as soon as possible, but not later than within 24 hours.
