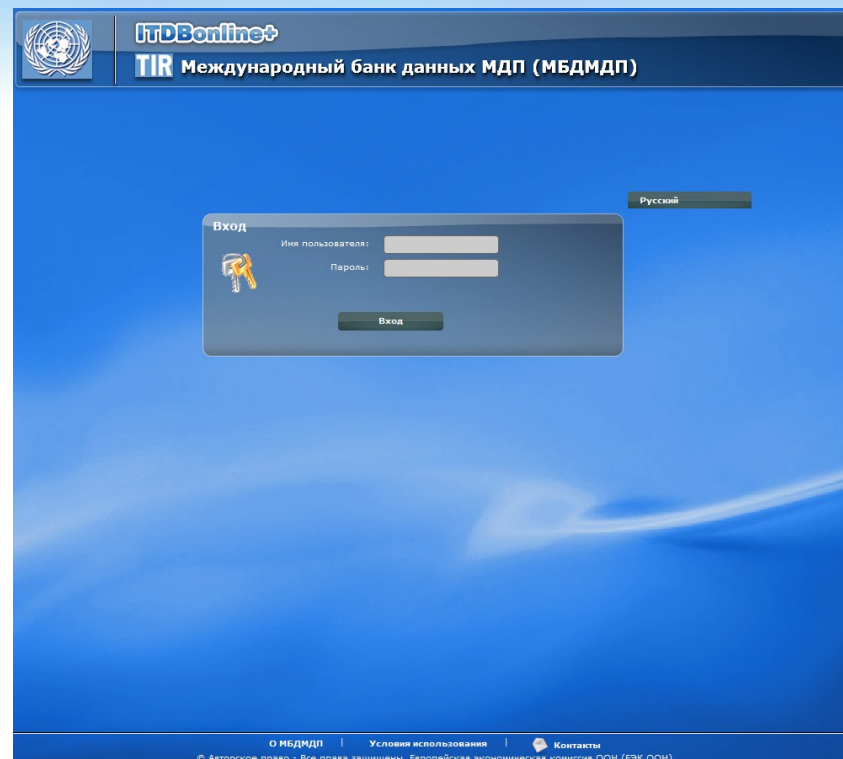

1. Customs Authorities

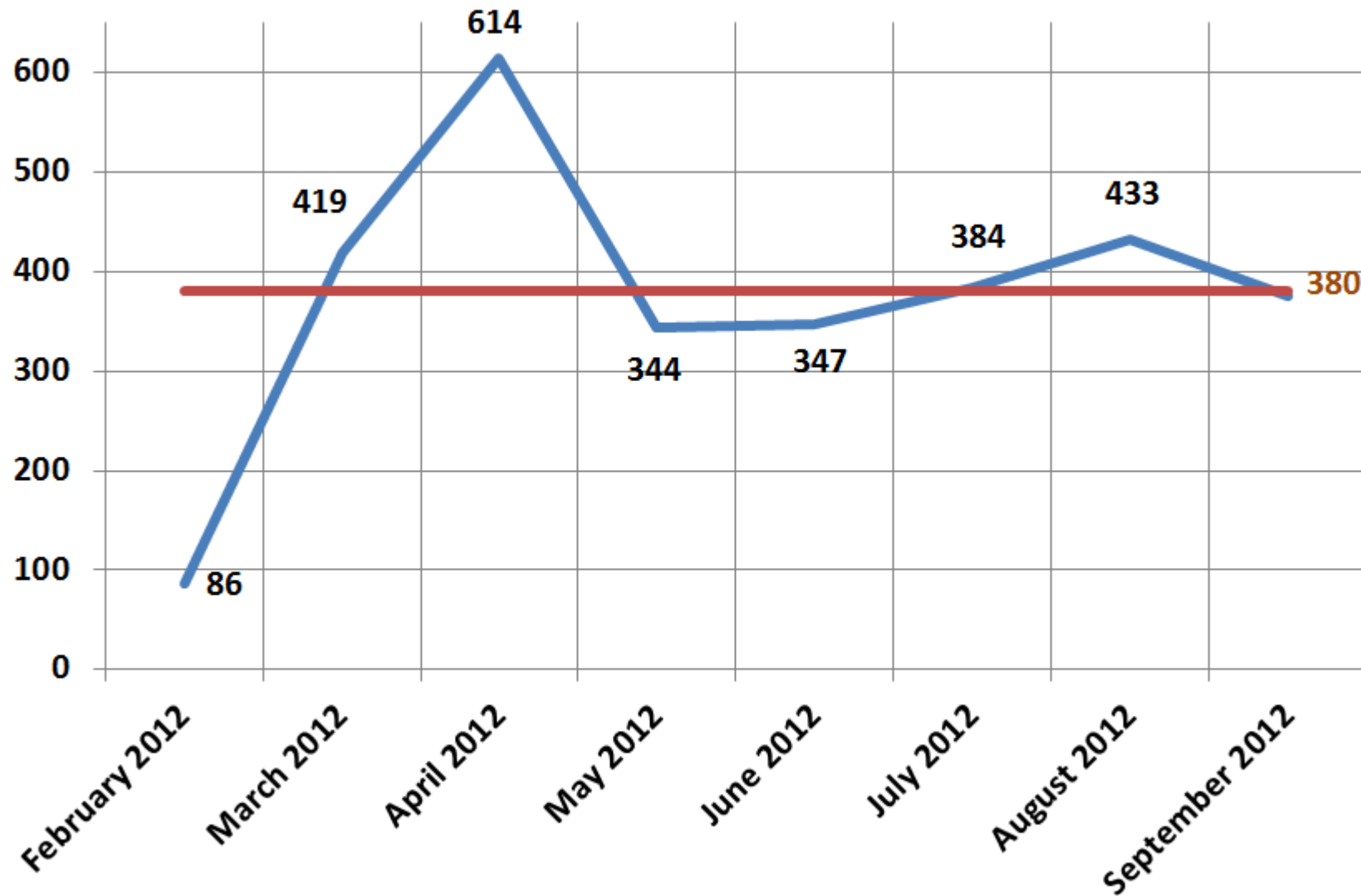
- 1267 users

- 7 countries



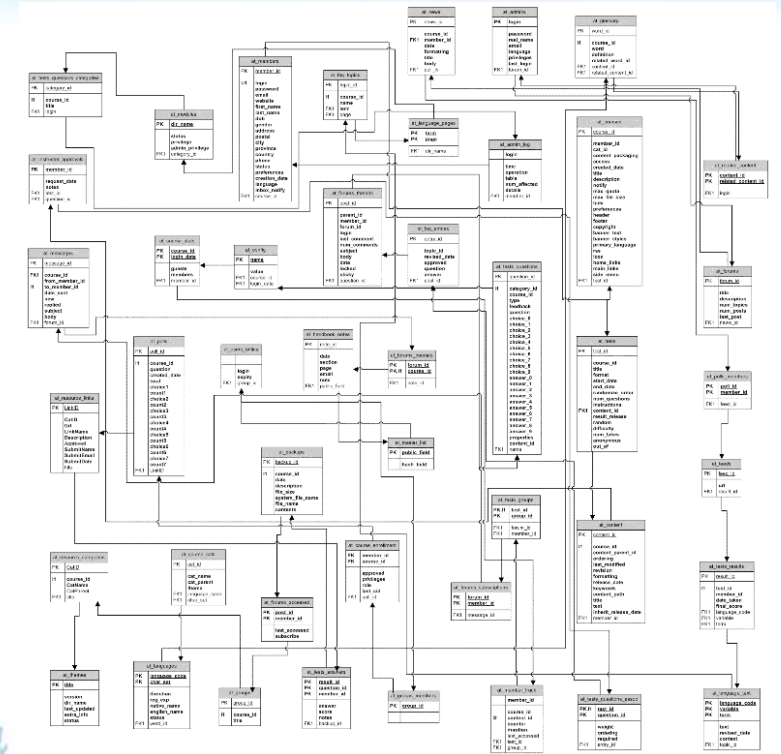
ITDB online+: users' search activity for TIR Carnet holders





Amendments in the International TIR Data Bank (ITDB)

1 March 2012 – 30 September 2012





ITDB online+ website in addition to consultation...

... facilitates the following amendments in the International TIR Data Bank(ITDB):

- Add new TIR Carnet holders**
- Update TIR Carnet holders (e.g. new address)**
- Withdraw temporarily or permanently**
- Notify the end of activity**
- Add or rehabilitate exclusions (Art. 38)**





How to perform amendments in the ITDB using ITDB online+ website?

Scenario 1:

- Customs authorities performs TIR Carnet holder's amendments directly online

Scenario 2: Collaborative scenario

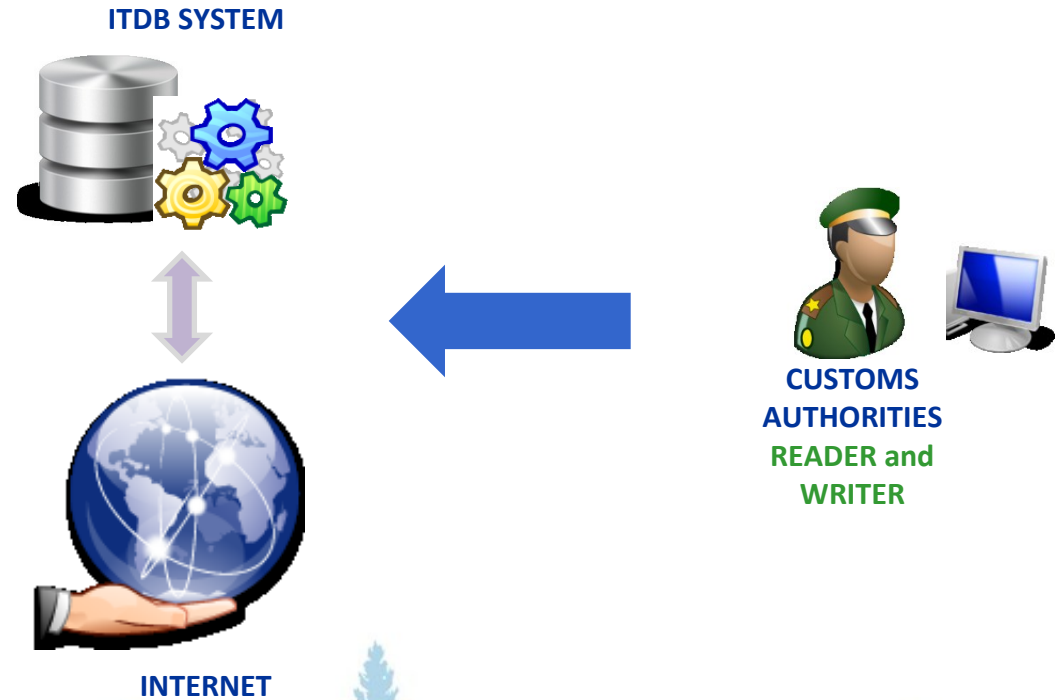
- The national association *proposes* a TIR Carnet holder's amendment in the International TIR Data Bank (ITDB)
- Then, Customs authorities validate the amendment "proposal"





Use of ITDB online+: scenario 1

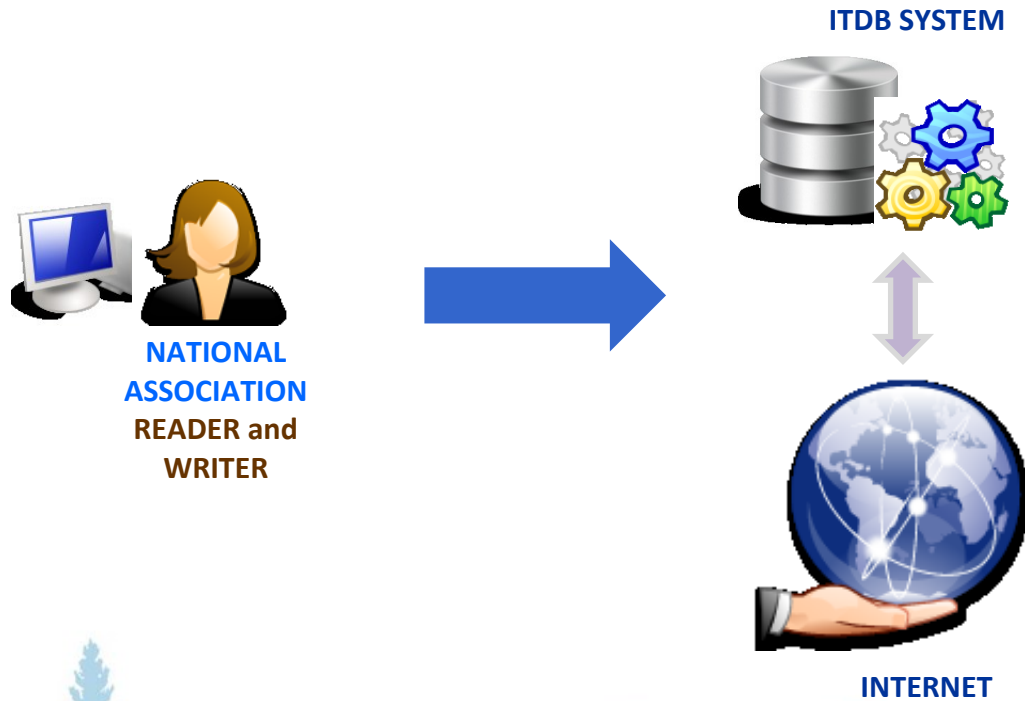
Customs Authorities performs TIR Carnet holder's amendments directly online





Use of ITDB online+: scenario 2

STEP 1 of 4 : The national association proposes a TIR Carnet holder's amendment





Use of ITDB online+: scenario 2

STEP 2 of 4: The system sends an e-mail notifying the Customs Authorities contact(s) to take action

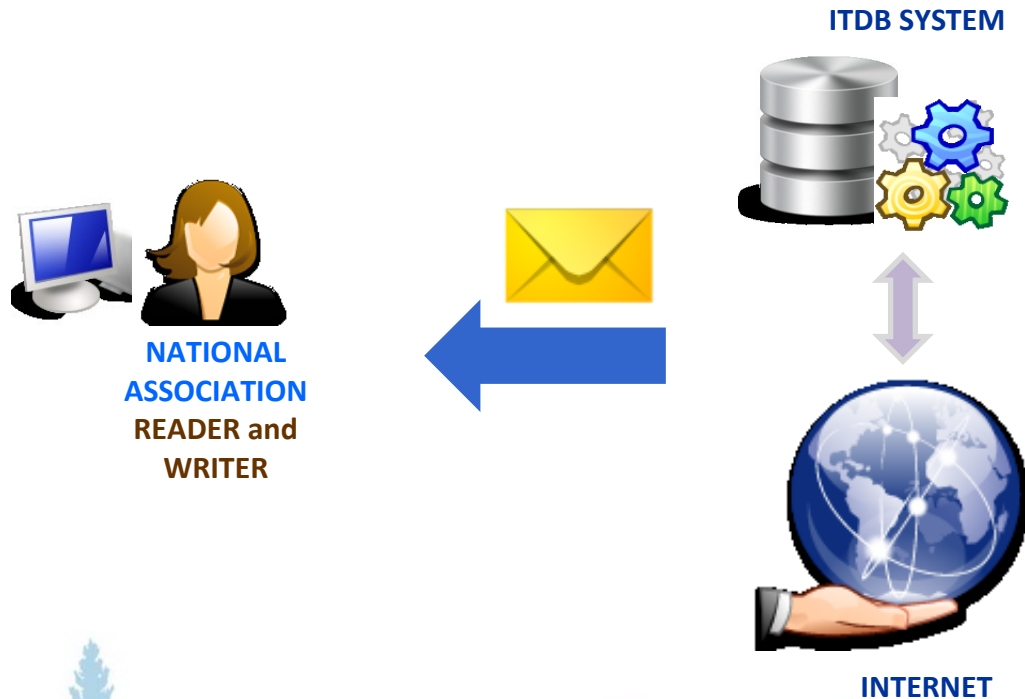
STEP 3 of 4: Customs Authorities validate the amendment proposal





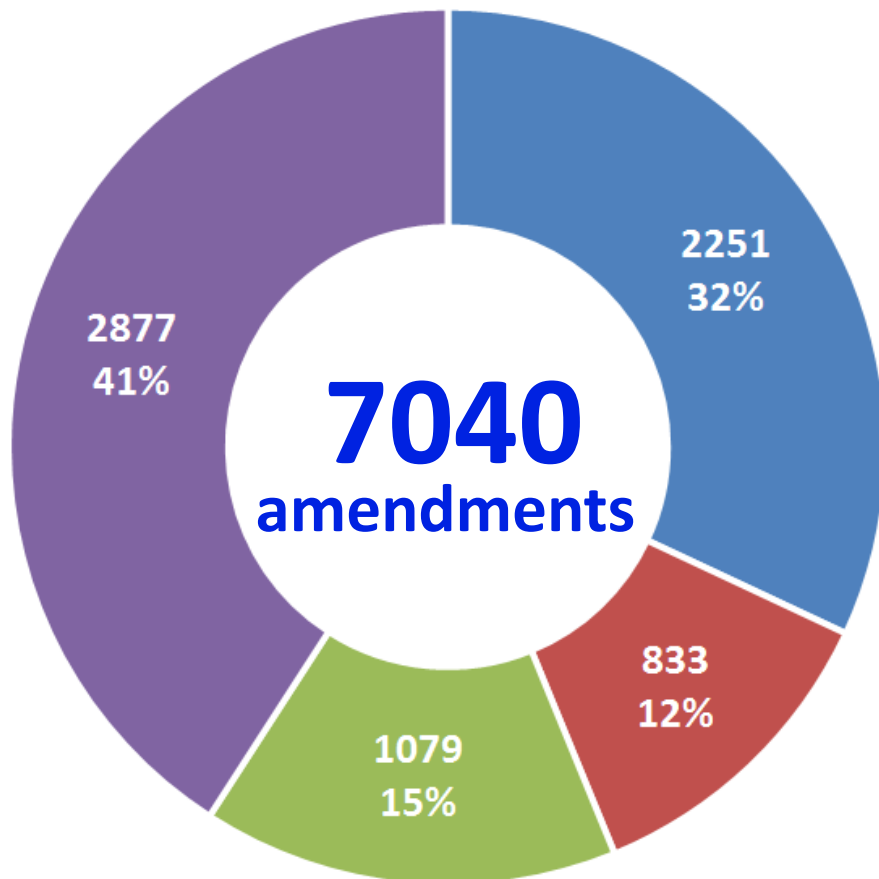
Use of ITDB online+: scenario 2

STEP 4 of 4: The system sends an e-mail to the national association notifying that the proposal has been validated





Summary of amendments in the ITDB: March 2012 – September 2012



- Approved amendments by Customs submitted by associations
- Amendments made directly by Customs
- Amendments made by the TIR secretariat manually
- Amendments made by the TIR secretariat – tir files

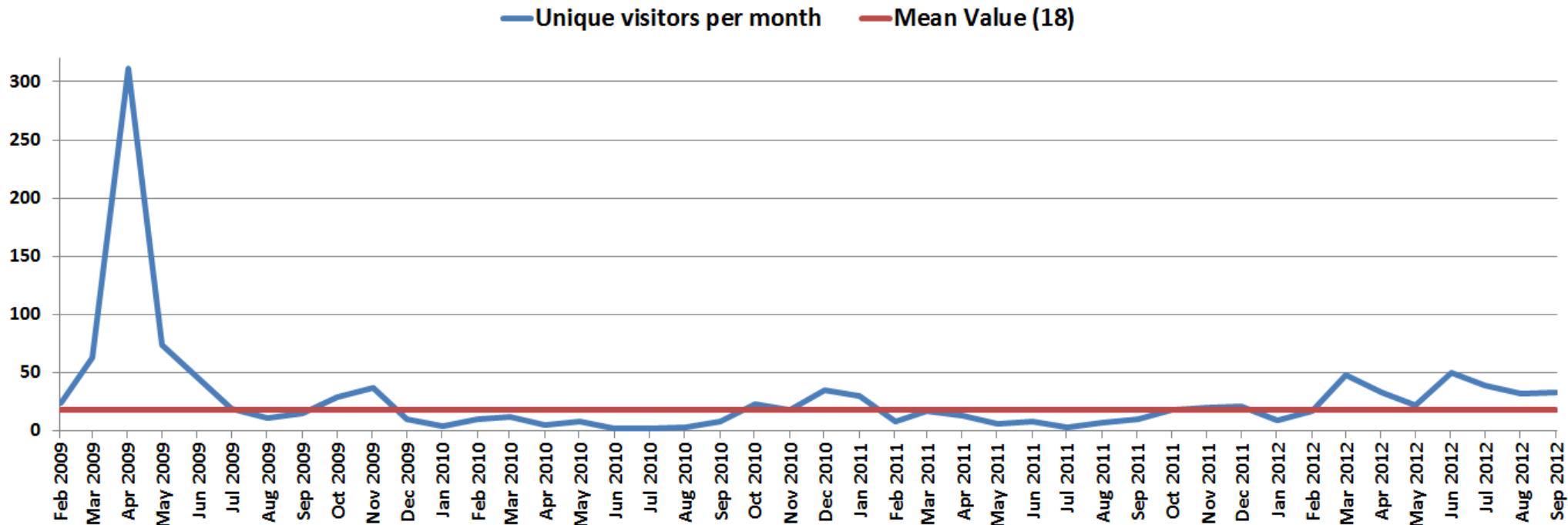

1267 users (31 countries) as of 30 September 2012

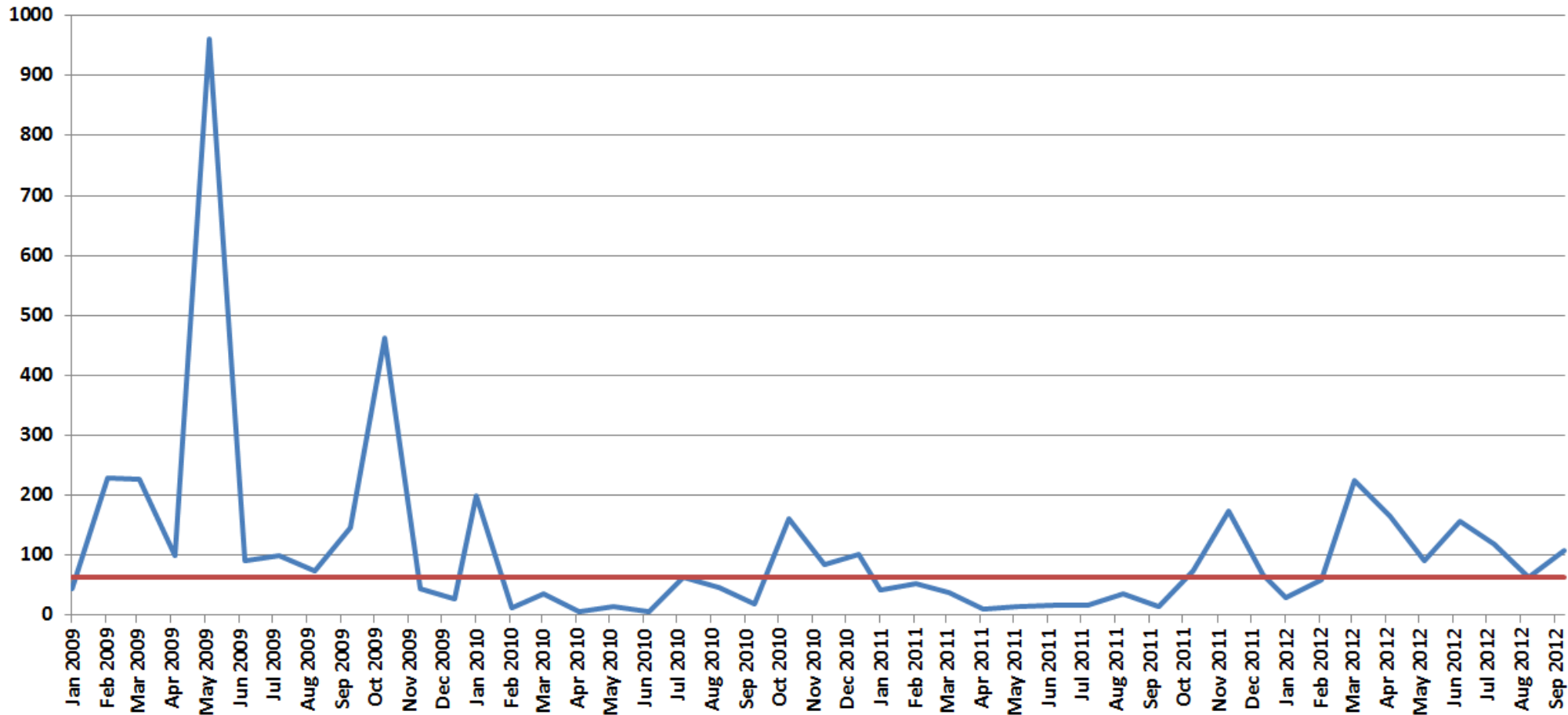
(Note: Customs officers have access to the

Follow-up Activities

- 1. Maintain the quality of the ITDB data in collaboration with the TIR Focal Points (e.g. excel files)**
- 2. Promote the use of ITDB online+ and UNECE Register of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps websites**
 - Increase awareness about functionalities and benefits of these tools
 - Outreach to Russian-speaking countries (translation of user guides)
- 3. Promote collaborative use of the ITDB online+ between Customs Authorities and national associations**





Conclusions

- **Two services are available to increase efficiency and effectiveness in the TIR procedure**
- **ITDB online+ website meets the needs from Customs by :**
 - providing an easy data transfer into the International TIR Data Bank (ITDB)
 - allowing faster amendments in the ITDB, thus faster availability of data
 - minimizing costs
 - complying with the TIR Convention Annex 9 – Part II, paragraph 4 “The competent authorities shall transmit within one week from the date of authorization or withdrawal of authorization to use TIR Carnets...”
- **National associations benefit from a free-of-charge tool to manage their TIR Carnet holders directly with Customs Authorities**
