

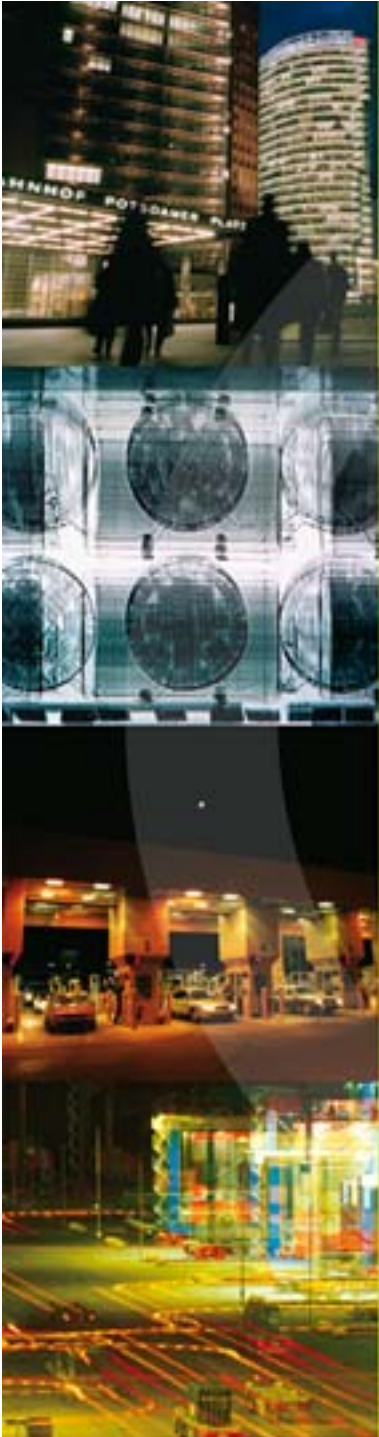

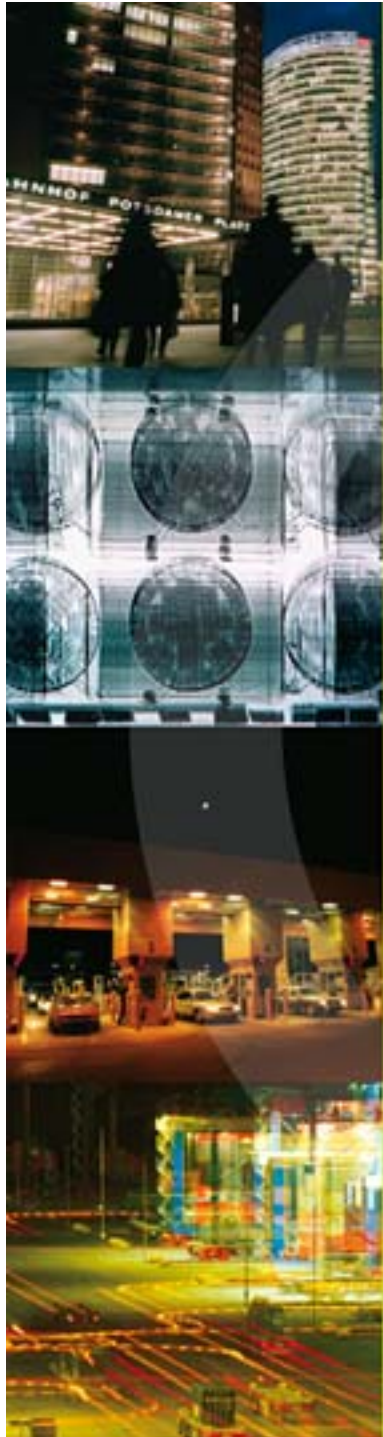

Current situation

NL Cross Border Regulatory Agencies

- Not WCO compliant
- Sagitta
- Sector specific
- Paper based

Problems with current standards (1/3)

- To many different Customs standards
- Example 1: **WCO ID 137** - Description of goods

Sagitta Manifest Import

Description of goods	an..256	Plain language description that is precise enough for Customs services to be able to identify the goods
----------------------	---------	---

Sagitta Import

Goods description	an..260	Specific description of the goods according to the applicable provisions
-------------------	---------	--

NCTS

Goods description	an..280	Description
-------------------	---------	-------------



Problems with current standards (2/3)

- Example 2: **WCO ID T010** - Mode/type of means of transport crossing the border, coded

Sagitta Manifest Import

Transport mode, coded	an..3	Mode/type of means of transport crossing the border of Customs territory, coded.
-----------------------	-------	--

Sagitta Import

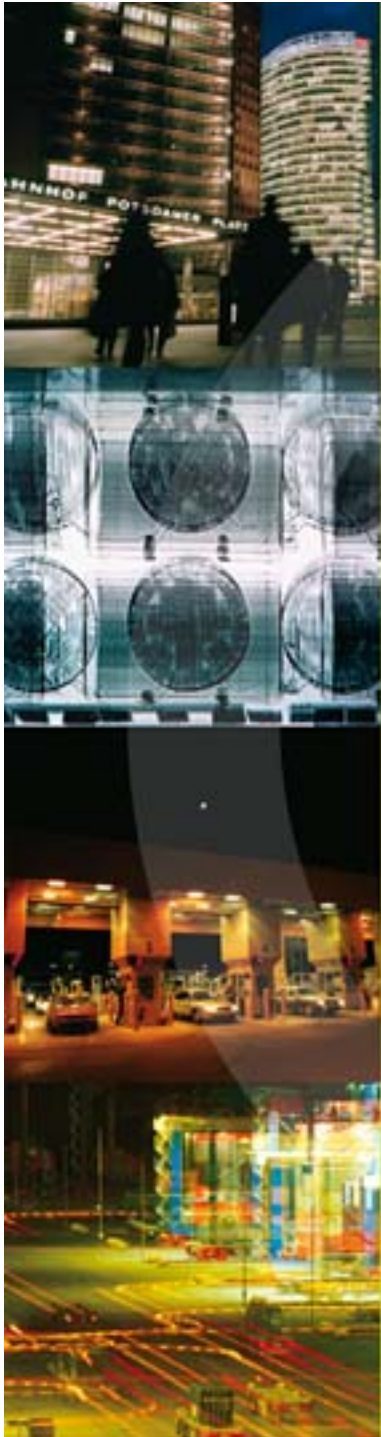
Transport mode at border	n1	Designation of the mode of transport when crossing the EU borders, regarding the active transport
--------------------------	----	---

NCTS

Transport mode at border	n..2	
--------------------------	------	--

Problems with current standards (3/3)

- Sagitta is a national Customs standard
- Several government standards
- Single Window



Australian example



In Australia the name of the “Exporter” is used:

- By 22 Agencies
- 212 times
- On 118 forms
- 61 different definitions
- 16 different formats (between 20 to 300 characters)

Is standardized in “Exporter, name”, format an..70
