
Project phases

Phase	High-level activities	
Inception	0	Idea is conceived, and initially documented using the UMM.
	0	Main workflows are: 1) Business Domain Modelling, and 2) e- Business requirements.
Elaboration	0	Idea is further refined and expanded
	0	Main workflows are: 1) Analysis, and 2) Design
	0	The outcome – deliverables – is compared with the already defined models, requirements and references contained in the 'repository'
	0	New models or enhancements to existing models are incorporated into the repository
Construction	0	Messages are designed
	0	Software development
	0	Main workflows are: 1) Implementation, 2) Testing, and 3) Deployment
Transition	0	Testing
	0	Main workflow is Deployment





Step-by-step iterative approach of UMM







Inception and elaboration phases

- Receive requests (including surveys) related to the eTIR project originating from WP.30, its Expert Groups and the secretariat, coordinate with the relevant national experts (including with the colleagues from other ministries if necessary) and reply within deadlines.
- Remain informed of the eTIR project developments, including the eTIR documentation prepared for GE.1 meetings, and provide the relevant feedback if necessary.
- Ensure that the eTIR project's objectives and envisaged implementation are in line with their national strategies towards the computerization of customs procedures, in particular the transit procedure.
- Promote the eTIR project nationally (across ministries) in order to ensure awareness about the project and its inclusion in mid- and long-term national ICT development and maintenance plans.
- Contribute actively to the meetings of GE.1, either by direct attendance or by submitting documents.
