A. BACKGROUND

- 1. At its third session on 1 and 2 September 2003 in Budapest, the Informal ad hoc Expert Group (hereafter called the Expert Group) requested the secretariat to draft a more detailed wording of Requirement 25 of Annex 1 (a TIR Transport must be guaranteed) (Decision No. 17) and to amend the Glossary in Annex 2 with the term "transport operator/driver", together with its definition (Decision No. 25).
- 2. At the same time, the secretariat proposes to amend Annex 2 with a number of other terms (new issue No. 36).

B. PROPOSAL BY THE SECRETARIAT

2. Annex 1, requirement 25: <u>replace</u> the existing statement by the following:

"A TIR Transport must be guaranteed by associations approved in accordance with the provisions of Article 6 of the Convention"

3. Annex 2, <u>insert</u> the following terms:
