INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE HARMONIZATION
OF FRONTIER CONTROLS OF GOODS

GENEVA, 21 OCTOBER 1982

PROPOSAL OF A NEW ANNEX 8 TO THE CONVENTION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 19 February 2007, the Administrative Committee for the International Convention on the Harmonization of Frontier Controls of Goods, 1982 of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) transmitted to the Secretary-General, in accordance with the provisions of article 22 of the above-mentioned Convention, a proposal of a new Annex 8 to the Convention, adopted at its eighth session held in Geneva on 3 and 4 October 2005.

The Administrative Committee decided that, in accordance with Article 22 of the Convention, the proposal will come into force with respect to all Contracting Parties three months after the expiry of a period of twelve months following the date of communication by the Secretary-General of the United Nations to the proposed amendment during which period no objection to the proposed amendment has been communicated to the Secretary-General by a State which is a Contracting Party.
