Cyprus: Reservation¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 1 August 2002, the Secretary-General received from the Government of Cyprus the following reservation in respect of article 20, paragraphs 2 to 7 of the above Convention:

AThe Republic of Cyprus does not consider itself bound by article 20, paragraphs 2 to 7, of the International Convention on the Harmonization of Frontier Controls of Goods concerning the settlement of disputes.@

In keeping with the depositary practice followed in similar cases, the Secretary-General proposes to receive the reservation in question for deposit in the absence of any objection on the part of any of the Contracting States, either to the deposit itself or to the procedure envisaged, within a period of one year from the date of the present of notification. In the absence of any such objection, the said reservation will be accepted for deposit upon the expiration of the above-stipulated period, that is on 7 August 2003.
