Criteria required

to be appointed

Authorised consignee

- To be established in a contracting party of the TIR convention
- To have a significant and regular traffic (receive goods regularly)
- To be capable of fulfilling the obligations
- To bring evidence to the relevant customs authorities that he will respect the legal requirements of the procedure.
- Not have committed serious or repeated infringements of customs legislation

And if:



 Customs can ensure the supervision and control of the procedure without establishing a mechanism that is disproportionate in relation to the needs of the operator



• the operator has accounts that enable the customs to carry out effective controls

Authorisation procedure

Operator




- Written dated signed request
- Requirement to provide the data necessary to deal with the request
- Responsibility for the information provided

Customs



- treatment of the request
- Maximal dealing (to study the procedure) at the will of C.P.



Transport Status of authorised consignee

- competent office of destination : RUNGIS (FR)

- following receipt on its premises, the operator is responsible for the goods and must submit the TIR carnet and other documents to the competent authorities

- waiting period : 30 minutes

Transport Status of authorised consignee

- obligations of the operator:

- --- arrival advice transmission
- --- immediate notification of the customs office of any anomaly regarding the goods (surpluses, missing goods, replacements) or the vehicle (the state of the seals, TIR identification plate, for example).
- --- submit to the office (by the next day) of TIR carnet, Certificate of agreement, copy of arrival advice and means of transport is required to be at the disposal of customs authorities and submit to inspection at the first request.
- --- the release of the means of transport can only be authorized after the TIR carnet discharge. This implies that the consignee has to give this carnet back and to issue a certificate of agreement to the transporter.

STATUS of AUTHORISED CONSIGNEE FINAL AUTORISATION

FACILITIES GRANTED:

- take delivery of the goods convoyed under TIR directly on its premises
