As regards the language in which the checklist is to be printed (7.2.4.10.3), it is proposed that French, German and Russian should be used and, if necessary, the language of the country in which the cargo transfer station is located.

As regards safety advisers (section 1.8.3), it was decided to propose that the Joint Meeting of Experts should introduce amendments into the German and Russian versions of 1.8.3.17.
