Part I - Proposals for amendments to the Protocol on Road Markings additional to the European Agreement supplementing the Vienna Convention on Road Signs and Signals

I. <u>Annex</u>

Amend paragraph 6 to read:

"6. Ad Article 29 of the Convention

Paragraph 2

This paragraph to read as follows:

'The road markings shall be white. The term "white" includes shades of silver or light grey. However:

 markings showing places where parking is subject to some conditions or restrictions may be blue;'

(rest of text unchanged)."

Part II - Explanatory notes

The proposal is intended to bring the text into line with the new provisions proposed in Article 29.2 of the Vienna Convention on Road Signs and Signals.
