SUMMARY

Executive summary:

In accordance with 1.1.3.2 (d), fire extinguishers as a load are also exempted. In fact, this is in contradiction with special provision 594.

Action to be taken:

Word 1.1.3.2 (d) to read:

(d) gases contained in the equipment used for the operation of the vehicle (e.g. fire extinguishers), even as spare parts or as a load (e.g. inflated pneumatic tyres).

Introduction

Exemptions for spare parts and for the load should refer to inflated pneumatic tyres only, since the carriage of fire extinguishers is subject to special provision 594.

"(d) gases contained in the equipment used for the operation of the vehicle (e.g. fire extinguishers), even as spare parts or as a load (e.g. inflated pneumatic tyres)."
