Note by the secretariat

After the tenth session of the Sub-Committee, attention of the secretariat was drawn to the fact that the inhalation cut-off value of 2500 ppm (volume) for acute toxicity Category 3 (gases) (4 hour exposure) in chapter 3.1 of the GHS, corresponds to the inhalation cut-off value of 5000 ppm (2 hour exposure) in the transport regulations. Therefore, the following corrections should be made to the table in INF.16:

In the line "Category 4" for Chapter 3.1 (Acute toxicity) (gases), replace "done*" with "Not applicable" (7 times), and delete footnote *.
