#### NEW PROPOSALS OF AMENDMENTS TO RID/ADR/ADN

### Obligations of the Packer with regard to Overpacks

## <u>Transmitted by the Government of Austria</u> \*/

In Austria, the opinion is predominant that the packer according to 1.4.3.2 b) RID/ADR/ADN when he prepares the packages for carriage shall also comply with the requirements concerning marking and labelling of overpacks.

Since, however, in 1.4.3.2 b) only "packages" are mentioned, it is brought forward in order to avoid misunderstandings to add "and overpacks" at the end of 1.4.3.2 b).
