1. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

3. STATUS OF THE EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY INLAND WATERWAYS (ADN)

As of 28 October 2005, the Agreement had been signed (subject to ratification) by 10 States:

Bulgaria; Croatia; Czech Republic; France; Germany; Italy; Luxembourg; Netherlands; Republic of Moldova; Slovakia.

The Netherlands deposited an instrument of acceptance on 30 April 2003.

The Russian Federation acceded to ADN on 10 October 2002, Hungary on 4 May 2004 and Austria on 9 November 2004.

The Meeting will be informed of any further developments.

4. PROPOSALS FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS ANNEXED TO ADN
