#### ATTENDANCE

- 1. The Meeting of Experts for the recognition of classification societies under the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Inland Waterways was held in Bonn on 30 June and 1 July 2004 at the invitation of the Government of Germany. Representatives of the following countries took part in its work: Austria; Czech Republic; France; Germany; Republic of Moldova. The Central Commission for the Navigation of the Rhine (CCNR) was also represented.
- 2. The secretariat was ensured jointly by Germany and the Central Commission for the Navigation of the Rhine.

#### ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

3. The Meeting of Experts adopted the agenda as proposed by the Government of Germany.

#### **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

- 4. Mr. H. Rein (Germany) was elected Chairman.
- 5. On the proposal of the Chairman, the preparation of the report was entrusted to Mr. Beck (Germany) and Mr. Fessmann (CCNR).

# RECOGNITION OF THE CLASSIFICATION SOCIETIES RUSSIAN RIVER REGISTER (RRR), BUREAU VERITAS (BV), LLOYDS REGISTER OF SHIPPING (LR) AND GERMANISCHER LLOYD (GL)

6. It was noted that all the documents still to be furnished (see document TRANS/WP.15/AC.2/2004/2) were currently available.

At the request of the Chairman, the representatives of BV, LR and GL gave an overall presentation of their classification societies. The results of the detailed consideration of the application of the four classification societies are set out in the following table:
