## TRANS/WP.15/AC.2/2005/4 page 2

#### 1.10.1.3 Amend to read:

"Areas within the boundaries of terminals and berthing areas used for the temporary storage of vessels carrying dangerous goods in zones of trans-shipment points for dangerous goods shall be properly secured, well lit and, where possible and appropriate, not accessible to the general public."

#### 1.10.3.3 Amend the first sentence to read:

"Operational or technical measures shall be taken on vessels carrying the high consequence dangerous goods referred to in 1.10.5 in order to prevent the improper use of the vessel or of the dangerous goods."
