The Ministry of Transport and Communications and its local bodies verify that carriers have vehicle certificates when they transport perishable foodstuffs.	There is general supervision of road transport carriers and of the number of violations detected. There is no specific supervision for the transport of perishable foodstuffs.	If the corresponding documentation is missing, the carrier is liable to an administrative penalty as follows: for individuals and legal entities in small and medium-sized enterprises, between 10 and 15 times the established minimum notional unit, and for those in large enterprises, between 20 and 25 times the established minimum notional unit.
Remarks/amendments: International carriage by rail (including carriage of perishable foodstuffs) is effected in accordance with the Agreement on International Goods Transport by Rail (SMGS).
