Subsection 4.1.4.1: Packing instruction P650, paragraph 8 (a)

"When dry ice or liquid nitrogen is used to keep specimens cold, <u>all applicable requirements of RID/ADR/ADN</u> shall be met."

What are these requirements?

What is the situation of special provision 319 of chapter 3.3 which refers only to "packages" and "marking" in accordance with packing instruction P650?

Are the "applicable requirements" referred to above packing and marking requirements for liquid nitrogen?

It would seem that a clarification common to these questions is required.
