**AMENDMENT TO THE PROPOSAL FOR SUPPLEMENT 14 TO THE 02 SERIES
OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION No. 48**

(Installation of lighting and light-signalling devices)

Submitted by the Administrative Committee

Note: The following amendment has been adopted by the Administrative Committee (AC.1) of the amended 1958 Agreement at its thirty-second session, following the recommendation by WP.29 at its one-hundred-and-thirty-eighth session (TRANS/WP.29/1050, paras. 72. and 45.).

Page 2, paragraph 2.7.

For the existing text substitute

2.7. "Lamp" means a device designed to illuminate the road or to emit a light signal to other road users. Rear registration plate lamps and retro-reflectors are likewise to be regarded as lamps. For the purpose of this Regulation, light-emitting rear registration plates and the service-door-lighting system according to the provisions of Regulation No. 107 on vehicles of categories M₂ and M₃ are not considered as lamps.
