Consolidated Resolution on Road Traffic (R.E.1)

# (a) Restructuring of R.E.1

5. The updated structure of R.E.1 appears in ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2005/15/Rev.6. This document is provided for reference only. The Working Party is not expected to discuss it.

#### (b) Special rules concerning certain categories of vehicles

6. The Working Party may wish to examine the draft text for R.E.1 on special rules concerning certain categories of vehicles (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/12/Rev.1) revised by the secretariat on the basis of decisions adopted by WP.1 at its 53<sup>rd</sup> session.

# (c) Safety at road works and at the scene of an incident/accident

7. The Working Party will have before it the draft text for R.E.1 concerning safety at road works and at the scene of an incident/accident (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/21/Rev.1) originally prepared by the representative of France and the secretariat and revised by the secretariat on the basis of decisions and discussions of WP.1 at its 52<sup>nd</sup> session.

#### (d) General rules regarding vehicles and their equipment

8. The Working Party may wish to examine the draft text for R.E.1 revised by the secretariat concerning vehicles and their equipment (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/23/Rev.1)

The Working Party may wish to consider for adoption the draft text (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2007/3/Rev.1) concerning instruction of children in safe road behaviour (Annex 8 of R.E.1), originally prepared by the European Federation of Road Traffic Victims (FEVR) and revised by the secretariat on the basis of decisions and discussions of WP.1 at its 53<sup>rd</sup> session.

16. The Working Party may wish to examine a draft text for R.E.2 concerning signing for cycle routes (ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2006/24) prepared by the European Cyclists Federation (ECF) in partnership with the Cycling in Switzerland Foundation.

- 17. The Working Party will be informed about the results of the survey launched by the secretariat aimed at assessing the impact and effectiveness of the First United Nations Global Road Safety Week held from 23-29 April 2007.
- 18. As a contribution of the UNECE to the First United Nations Global Road Safety Week, the secretariat will inform the Working Party about the progress related to publication of the consolidated version of the Vienna Convention on Road Signs and Signals, as well as the European Agreement supplementing it and its Protocol on Road Markings.

- 19. The Working Party may wish to examine the document ECE/TRANS/WP.1/2008/3 concerning sleeping coaches in international traffic in order to give its position to WP.29.
- 20. The Working Party may wish to discuss any other business under this agenda item.
