## A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 5.2.6., in English, French and Russian versions, amend to read:

"5.2.6. Except as provided in paragraph 5.2.9. 5.2.7., all identifications of tell-tales, indicators and controls listed in table 1 or ISO 2575:2000 must appear to the driver perceptually upright. In case of rotating control, this paragraph applies to it when such control is in its "off" position."
