# UN 1704, tetraethyl dithiopyrophosphate

### Note by the secretariat

#### Introduction

- 1. In RID/ADR/ADN, UN 1704 is classified as T2 (organic, solid). However, the packing group for this substance is P001 (for liquids).
- 2. In the UN Model Regulations, P002 was initially affected to this substance. Considering that this substance is a liquid, and following an amendment to the IMDG Code (Amendment 30-00), this was corrected in the 12<sup>th</sup> Revised Edition on the basis of a proposal from the Netherlands and Germany (ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2001/14). The amendment, as reflected in ST/SG/AC.10/29/Add.1 was adopted by the Joint Meeting (TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/94/Add.3). However, the Joint Meeting did not discuss, at that time, possible consequential amendments in relation to this change.

# **Proposal**

The secretariat proposes the following amendments:
 In column (3b), amend the classification code to read T1.
 In column (16), delete V11.

4. In addition, the tank working group may wish to consider the deletion of SGAH in column (12).
