Classification of wastes, sub-section 2.1.3.5.5

Amend the third paragraph in 2.1.3.5.5 to read as follows (new text is underlined):

"2.1.3.5.5 If however, on the basis of the knowledge of the composition of the waste and the physical and chemical properties of the identified components, it is possible to demonstrate that the properties of the waste do not correspond to the properties of the packing group I level, the waste may be classified by default in the most appropriate n.o.s. entry of packing group II. Wastes that, because of its environmentally hazardous properties, only meet the criteria for classification into UN 3077 or UN 3082 in accordance with 2.2.9.1.10, may be assigned to PG III.".
