Based on doc. ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2011/27(WHO) and INF. 34 (Germany) the following amendments are proposed:

2.6.3.2.3.5 Amend to read as follows:

- 2.6.3.2.3.5 Dried blood spots, collected by applying a drop of blood onto absorbent material, are not subject to these Regulations. unless they meet the criteria for inclusion in another class.
- 2.6.3.2.3.6 Faecal occult blood screening samples are not subject to these Regulations. unless they meet the criteria for inclusion in another class.
- 2.6.3.2.3.7 Blood or blood components which have been collected for the purposes of transfusion or for the preparation of blood products to be used for transfusion or transplantation and any tissues or organs intended for use in transplantation<u>as well</u> as samples drawn in connection with such purposes are not subject to these Regulations<u>ulless</u> they meet the criteria for inclusion in another class.
