


By train:

From Lille Europe railway station, you first need to go to Lille Flandres railway station (5 minutes walking distance).

From Lille Flandres railway station, you can use regional (<u>TER</u>) trains connecting frequently Lille Flandres with Valenciennes to reach the Agency.
