Comments on proposal 2015/45 from the United Kingdom

Proposal

Amend RID/ADR/ADN as follows: (The base text shown below is from ADR 2015, 6.4.22.8, with underlined text in bold italics for additions. This amendment should be replicated in paragraph 6.4.22.8 of RID.

- 6.4.22.8 Any <u>package</u> design that requires unilateral approval originating in a country Contracting Party to ADR shall be approved by the competent authority of this country; if the country where the package has been designed is not a Contracting Party to ADR, carriage is possible on condition that:
 - (a) A certificate has been supplied by this country, proving that the package design satisfies the technical requirements of ADR, and that this certificate is countersigned validated by a competent authority of an intended ADR Contracting Party approval;
 - (b) If no certificate and no existing package design approval by a country Contracting Party to ADR has been supplied, the package design is approved by the competent authority an ADR <u>intended</u> Contracting Party <u>approval.</u>
