### **Updating of references to European Union instruments (toxic substances; corrosive substances; substances hazardous to the aquatic environment)**

**Transmitted by the European Chemical Industry Council  
(CEFIC)**

#### *Summary*

- Executive summary:** After the discussion in the plenary, CEFIC was asked to present an INF paper where the reference to the CLP regulation is made instead of the GHS. So this paper just shows the amended text, without any further explanation.
- Action to be taken:** Replace references in paragraphs 2.2.61.1.14, 2.2.8.1.9 and 2.2.9.1.10.5 b). Delete paragraph 2.2.9.1.10.5 a)
- Related documents:** ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/2014/39 submitted at the September 2014 session of the Joint Meeting and ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/2015/11 submitted at the March 2015 session of the Joint Meeting.

### **Proposals of amendments**

#### 2.2.61.1.14

Substances, solutions and mixtures, with the exception of substances and preparations used as pesticides, which are not classified as acute toxic category 1, 2 or 3 according to the Regulation 1272/2008/EC\*, may be considered as substances not belonging to class 6.1.

#### 2.2.8.1.9

Substances, solutions and mixtures, which

- Are not classified as corrosive to skin category 1 according to the regulation 1272/2008/EC\* ; and
- Do not exhibit a corrosive effect on steel or aluminium according to the regulation 1272/2008/EC\* may be considered as substances not belonging to Class 8.

NOTE: UN 1910 calciumoxide and UN No. 2812 sodium aluminate, listed in the UN Model Regulations, are not subject to the provisions of ADR/RID/ADN.  
2.2.9.1.10.5

Substances or mixtures classified as environiontally hazardous substances (aquatic environment) on the basis of Regulation 1272/2008/EC\*

If data for classification according to the criteria of 2.2.9.1.10.3 and 2.2.9.1.10.4 are not available a substance or mixture:

- (a) | Shall be classified as an environmentally hazardous substance (aquatic environment) if it has to be assigned category(ies) Aquatic Acute 1, Aquatic Chronic 1 or Aquatic Chronic 2 according to Regulation 1272/2008/EC\* |
- (b) May be regarded as not being an environmentally hazardous substance (aquatic environment) if it does not have to be assigned such a category according to the said Regulations.
