To support ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.1/2016/32.6.2.15, the following photographs show examples of pressure drums as well as the location of where marks are applied. From these photographs, it will be seen that the marking of pressure drums is not always easy to accomplish due to the location of the where the marks are needed to be applied, for example on the inside face of the pressure drum shroud.

By having the information engraved on a ring that is affixed to the cylinder when the valve is installed means that the marks can be applied in conditions that assist in the clarity of the marks.
