Special Authorizations

Transmitted by the Government of the Netherlands

I. Introduction

- 1. During the 27th session of the ADN Safety Committee, the Dutch Government was requested to verify whether it was still necessary to mention the two special authorizations (UN No. 2187, CARBON DIOXIDE, REFRIGERATED LIQUID, and UN No. 3295 HYDROCARBONS, LIQUID, N.O.S. CONTAINING ISOPRENE AND PENTADIENE (vp 50 > 110 kPa), STABILIZED) on the ECE website.
- 2. The Dutch Government has verified that the entries have since been introduced in Table C. The companies mentioned use these entries from Table C for the carriage of these substances and no longer depend on the special authorizations on the ECE website.

II. Proposal

3. Because the special authorizations are no longer in use, the Dutch Government proposes to withdraw the special authorizations and to delete them from the ECE website.
