# Highlights of the last WP.29 session (176<sup>th</sup>)



- WP.29 discussed GRVA priorities (WP.29-176-28). Revised version: ECE/TRANS/WP.29/2019/2.
- WP.29 invited GRVA to envisage follow-up activities of the TF on CS/OTA and to report back in March 2019.
- WP.29 discussed DETA and the possibility to make RxSWIN available for PTI.
- WP.29 requested the secretariat to circulate WP.29-176-21 to all GRs for prioritization of the candidate items and report back to the IWG on IWVTA.
- WP.29 referred WP.29-176-17 (Data Storage System for Automated Driving) to GRVA.
- The secretariat presented the draft new version of the “Bluebook” (see next slide).
- AC.1 adopted a Corrigendum to UN Regulation No. 55 as well as ~40 other Amend. / Corr.
- AC.2 discussed (among others) the priorities of GRVA and work coordination on ADVs.
- AC.3 adopted an amendment to UN GTR No. 9.
- AC.4 adopted two new UN Rules annexed to the 1997 Agreement.

The fourth edition of the Blue Book continues to provide precise information about the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) as serviced by the ECE Sustainable Transport Division: on its history, its administrative and legal framework as a guide for users, and on the three Agreements.

WP.29 administers the three major international United Nations Agreements on motor vehicles: the 1958 and 1998 Agreements on regulations for the certification of new vehicles, including performance requirements, and the 1997 Agreement on rules for periodical technical inspections of vehicles in use.

The Blue Book also provides guidelines for the accession by countries to these agreements.
