








CRS Harness Belts: Types and Incorrect Manipulations

	Type	Example of incorrect manipulation		Possibility of incorrect manipulation
5-point continuous CRS				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * No possibility of using belt only on one side. * Child will slip out if only one side is used.
Y-shaped CRS				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * No possibility of using belt only on one side. * Child will slip out if only one side is used.
5-point separation CRS		<p>(Case 1: Use of only shoulder restraint)</p> 	<p>(Case 2: Use of only lap strap)</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Possibility of Case 1 or Case 2. * Child can be held with shoulder restraint or lap strap only.
