#### **Future work**

#### **Key areas**

- Intermodal transport issues
  - Monitoring of policies and bottlenecks
  - Peer reviews of intermodal policies
  - Euro-Asian intermodal transport
  - Standardized loading units
  - Terminal, transshipment and logistical procedures
  - Civil liability regimes
- AGTC Agreement and Protocol on IWT
  - Administration and update
  - Extension of geographical scope and substantive issues
- Logistics and supply chain management

#### **Future work**

#### Re-organization of work

- Schedule and timing of meetings
  - One or two annual meetings
  - Support by ad hoc expert groups
  - Back-to-back meetings with other UNECE Groups
- Structure of the sessions
  - Start with issues of general interest
  - End with specific mandatory issues
- Introduction of themes, such as:
  - Intermodal transport and inland waterways
  - Response to the economic crisis
  - Intermodal transport and dry ports (hubs)
  - Land use planning: The role of terminals
  - Others .....
