Final disposal of spent nuclear fuel in Finland

- Mandated to Posiva Oy
 - owned by energy companies TVO (60 %) and Fortum Power & Heat (40 %) with 2+2 npp-units + I under construction
- EIA with 4 location alternatives 1998-99
 - Espoo-procedure with Sweden, Estonia and Russia
- 2001, the Parliament ratified the Government's decision-in-principle stating that the spent fuel from the nuclear power plants belonging to TVO and Fortum will be disposed of in Olkiluoto, Eurajoki
- EIA to expand the repository 2008
 - Espoo-procedure with Baltic Sea countries + neighbours
- 2010 parliament ratified Government's decision-in-principle for one more unit (OL 4)
- construction licence application to be submitted in 2012
- operation licence application to be submitted in 2018
- final disposal begins in 2020
