

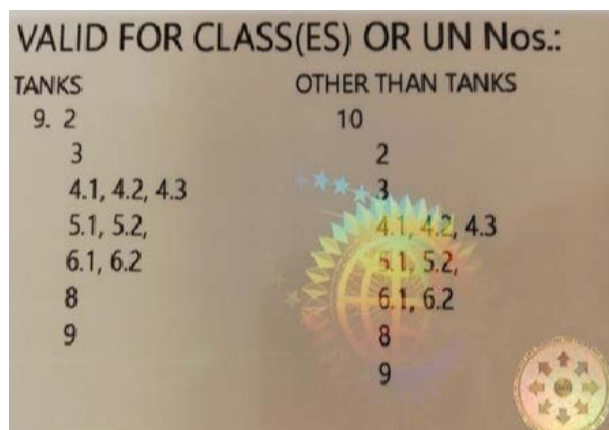

Explanatory notes from Ireland in accordance with ADR 8.2.2.8.6

The Health and Safety Authority (HSA) is the competent authority in Ireland for dangerous goods classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9. In relation to these classes of dangerous goods, the HSA appointed the Chartered Institute of Logistics Ireland (CILT) as the competent authority in 2019 to:

- approve driver basic and tanker specialisation training courses;
- examine persons who have completed such training; and
- issue driver training certificates.

Since 1st November 2019, ADR driver training certificates have been issued by CILT as the competent authority appointed by the HSA, and a sample of the current certificate issued by CILT is provided.

Prior to the appointment of CILT in 2019, ADR driver training certificates were issued by the HSA in Ireland. A sample certificate issued by the HSA up to 31st October 2019 is provided. This certificate is valid until 31st October 2024.
