Transport Observatory

Transport Community's flagship project:

- Performance monitoring of the TEN-T network in Western Balkans
- Key inputs for TEN-T projects planning and prioritisation
- Monitoring of the EU transport acquis transposition process within the 6 South East European Parties of the Transport Community

Two main analytical tools:

- The Transport Observatory Database/Information System (TODIS)
- The Regional Transport Model (to be developed at a later stage)

TODIS is currently under testing and shall soon be made publicly available via TCT website

Further cooperation is currently envisaged with ITC's Transport Observatory





- > contributes to harmonised road safety data in the region.






Enforcement of road transport rules
