

- Classes A, B, BS, CS or DS of the 01 and subsequent series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 149.

Optionally one additional pair type-approved according to:

- UN Regulations Nos. 98 or 112 or 113,

or

- Classes A, B, BS, CS, D, DS or ES of the 00 series of amendments to UN Regulation 149,

or

- Classes A, B, BS, CS, DS or RA of the 01 and susbsequent series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 149."

Paragraph 6.1.9.2., amend to read:

"6.1.9.2.

This maximum intensity shall be obtained by adding together the individual reference marks which are indicated on the several headlamps."

Paragraph 6.2.2., amend to read:

Two (or four - see paragraph 6.2.4.2.4.), type-approved according to

or

- Classes A, AS, B, BS, CS, D, DS or ES of the 00 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 149,
