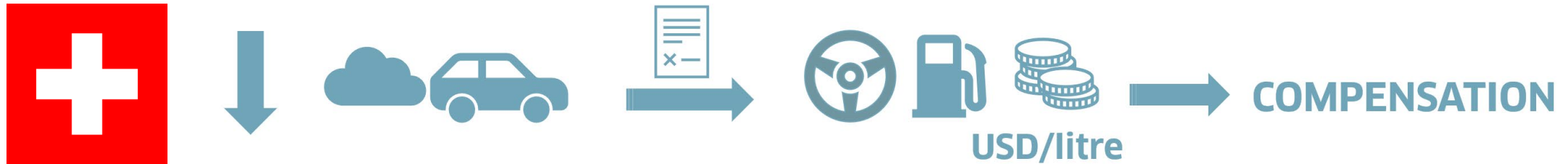

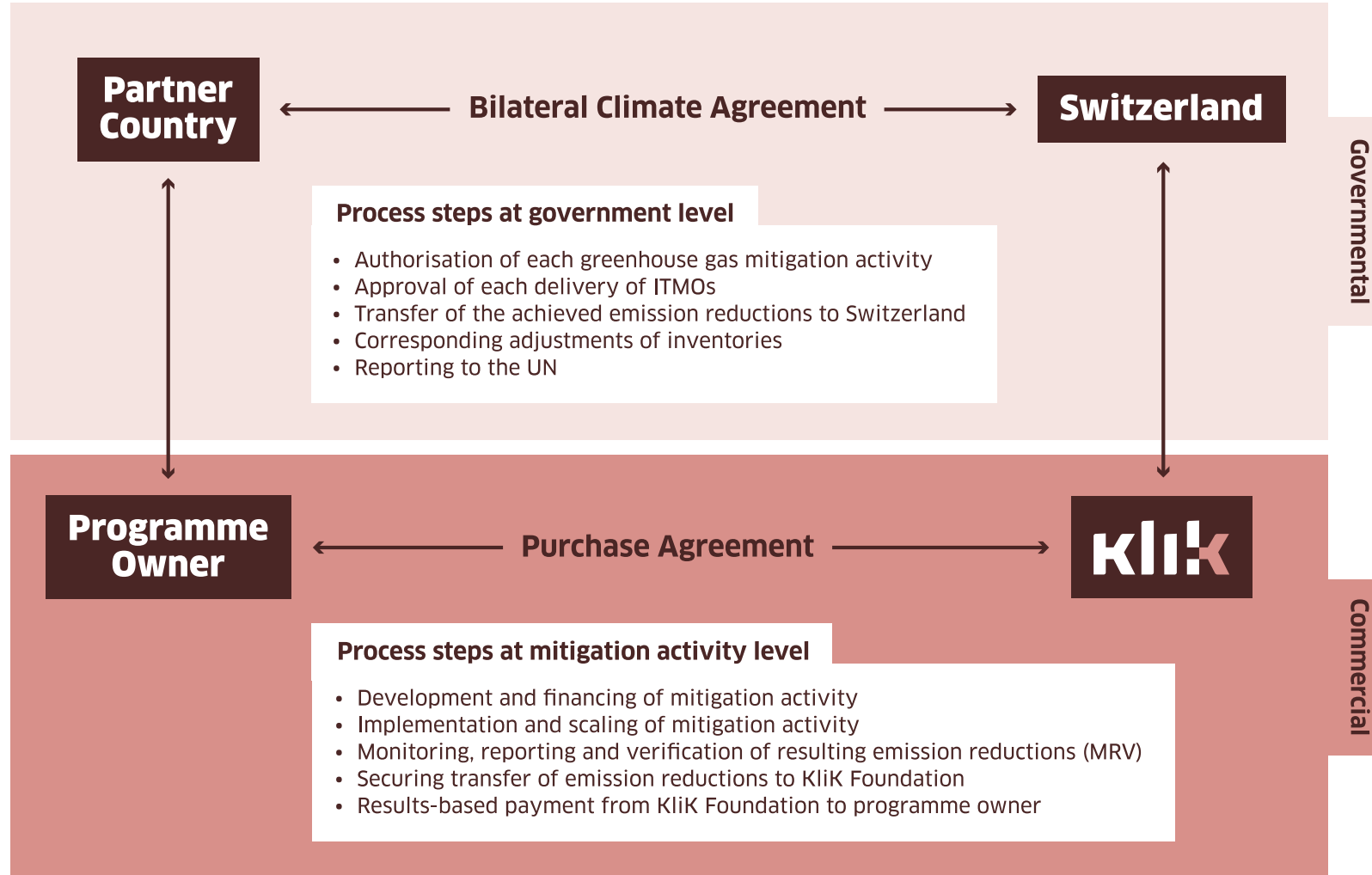
Who Is the KliK Foundation?



- ▶ Private entity with a legal mandate under the Swiss CO₂ law
- ▶ Compensating emissions from the Swiss transport sector nationally and globally (purchase of ITMOs—Internationally Transferred Mitigation Outcomes)
- ▶ Acting on behalf of Swiss motor fuel importers
- ▶ Obligated by Swiss law to buy 20 million ITMOs abroad (t CO₂e until 2030, 3-5 m per host country)
- ▶ ITMOs are sourced by the KliK Foundation from mitigation activities implemented in host country, and used by Swiss government to fulfil its NDC target

Guidance Through Bilateral Cooperation Agreements

- ▶ **Switzerland** is a **pioneer** on the bilateral track (Art. 6.2) and has already signed bilateral climate agreements with **several partner countries**.
- ▶ Bilateral Agreements set the **legal framework**, the **quality standards** and **procedural guidance** for transfers.
- ▶ KliK Foundation as **compliance buyer** comes in in a second step.

Mitigation Activity Types of Interest



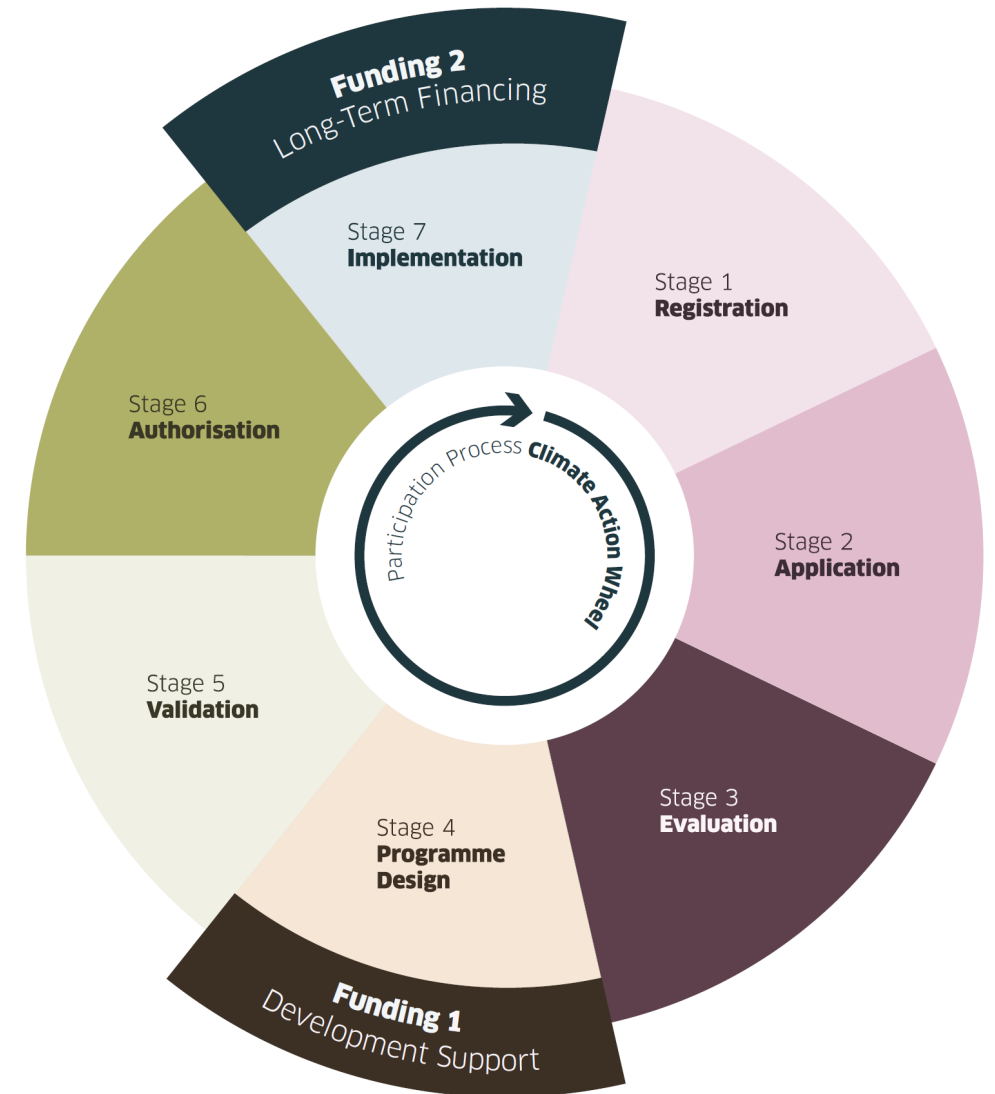
- ▶ We are looking for **additional activities** to the host country's **NDC**
- ▶ We are looking for **projects** that are unfinanceable without carbon revenue from **ITMO** sales
- ▶ We **cannot** support already **implemented** activities
- ▶ We are looking for **large mitigation activities** (>0.25M tonnes cumulative until 2030)
- ▶ We **do not fund** activities directly (we may help to invest capital or raise debt finance)
- ▶ Technology open but with some **restrictions**: e.g. no biological sequestration, nuclear power, fossil fuel lock-in, no large hydro



Procurement Process

General process comprises of 3 steps:

1. Presentation of project idea to KliK
2. Funding to develop project (**Funding 1**)
3. Authorisation of project by governments and long-term financial support from KliK through the purchase of carbon revenues (**Funding 2**)
