## <u>Programme Area 1</u>: Improving Governance for Water and Health Through Setting Targets, Implementing Measures and Reporting (new structure)

<u>Responsible bodies</u>: Task Force on Target Setting and Reporting and the Joint Secretariat <u>Lead Parties</u>: Portugal, Romania and Switzerland

- 1. Support to setting targets and implementing measures
- 2. Strengthening capacity to monitor progress and reporting
- 3. Improving governance on water and health at the national level through target setting support:
  - Capacity building projects (financed by individual donors, UNDA, etc.)
  - NPDs under "EU4Environment Water Resources and Environmental Data"
  - Biennial Collaborative Agreements and Country Cooperation Strategies (WHO/Europe)

### 13<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Task Force on Target Setting and Reporting (Geneva, 14<sup>th</sup> November 2023): <u>Key Outcomes</u>

- The Task Force Meeting was held back-to-back with the <u>Strategic Roundtable on Increasing Resilience to Climate Change in the Water and Sanitation Sector</u>. Therefore, it had a specific focus on increasing resilience to climate change.
- Participants discussed how the identified strategic priorities could be reflected in target-setting under the Protocol and welcomed the fact that countries such as Albania, Belarus, Montenegro, Norway, Portugal and Romania had set climate-sensitive targets (e.g. on wastewater treatment and reuse, analysing climate impact on drinking water quality, etc.)
- Participants also discussed how the Protocol's mandatory target setting and reporting mechanisms can serve as an effective tool for mainstreaming adaptation to climate change – for future consideration by the Task Force in 2024-2025 and beyond.
