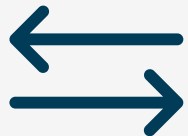

Breakdowns (i.e Nationality, reason for migration, demographic)

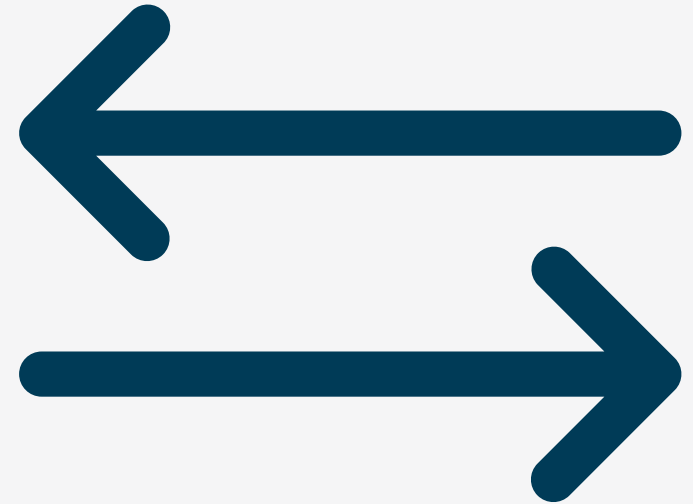

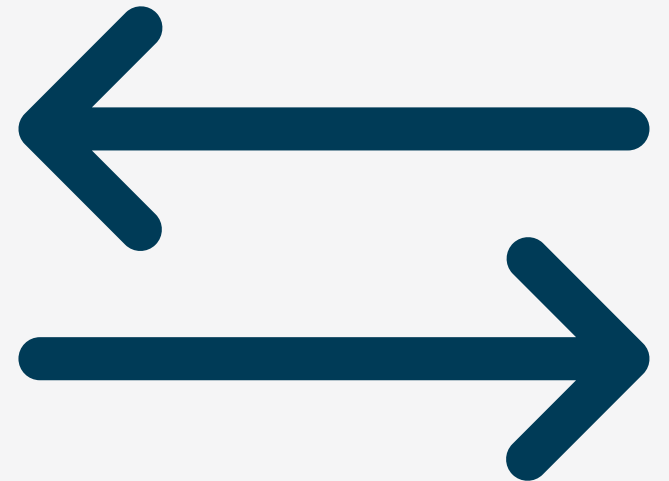
