Leasons learned and needs



Key challenges

- Long-term uncertainty in financing (monitoring, laboratories, staff etc.)
- Lack of capacity and expertise in air pollution research and policy
- Lack of awareness at different levels of society
- Need for further development of the legal framework (harmonization of international standards)
- Need for substantial modernization of industrial sectors (BAT application)

Further needs

- Awareness-raising campaigns to promote technical guidance (e.g., good agricultural practice in GE)
- National clean air dialogues to follow up on National Action Plans (AM, AZ, KZ)
- Emission projections and setting national emission reduction targets (AM, MK)
- Improve and maintain emission reporting
- Cooperation and exchange of information
