












Major Achievements to Date



<u>Cooperation</u>





- <u>25th session of the SPECA Working Group on Sustainable Transport, Transit and Connectivity the platform that fosters cooperation and enhances regional dialogue while being a knowledge and good practices sharing point for inland transport;</u>
- This year focus on regional connectivity (infrastructure development, removing of bottlenecks), international transport (border crossing facilitation and corridor management), COVID-19 response as well as road safety;
- United Nations transport-related legal instruments an efficient tool to improve transport corridors in SPECA region report;
- Countries should further support this group and especially the development of the SPECA Transport Connectivity Strategy.
