How national, regional and international statistical coordination can be capitalized on/improved

## Refugee Statistical Framework

Persons with a refugee background
Persons returned from abroad after seeking international protection (returnees)


## IDPs in locations of return

IDPs in other settlement locations

## DP-related populations:

 children of at least one IDP parent
## Other non-displaced <br> family members of IDPs

## Locally integrated

The total stock of IDPs (persons who have displacement-related protection needs and vulnerabilities) is divided into three sub-stocks, which correspond to different locations and reflect the content of the Guiding Principles on Internal Displacement and the IASC Framework on Durable Solutions for Internally Displaced Persons.

Should be counted as a separate but related statistical category.

Should not be included as a statistical category in official IDP statistics.

No longer within the stock of IDPs but recommended to be reported on as a separate statistical category.
